Government college Nedumangad strictly follows the reservation criteria of allotting 3 % seats out of the total available seats for each course to disabled candidates. We have students with physical disability, hearing impairment and visual impairment. The college is taking utmost care in providing facilities to address accessibility related issues of the disabled students and staff as per the stipulations of the Persons with Disabilities Act 1995, and ensure that all existing structures as well as future construction projects in the campus are made disabled friendly.

To meet the requirements of Differently abled the college offers following facilities

Physical Facilities: The College provides special facilities for the differently abled students to provide them with opportunities to acquire quality education and to bring them into the main stream of the society. The college provides wheel chairs, crutches, walk sticks to facilitate the easy movement of persons who have physical disability. As far as possible classes of such students are arranged in the ground floor of buildings. Student volunteer groups from NSS are readily available for helping the students reach their respective classrooms.





Ramp and Rails

The college has the facility of ramp and rails in all the major blocks for the differently abled students. The main entrances and exits are made clearly identifiable and easily accessible. And it can accommodate wheelchair users. Steps and ramps are provided with hand railings.





Rest Rooms

We have two rest rooms which are made disabled-friendly. There is separate corner in the Rest Room to facilitate the access of disabled students. One toilet in the rest room is disabled friendly and they are clearly identifiable and accessible.





Scribes for Examination

There are some students with disability who find it difficult to write examinations themselves and they need scribes to help them. The college allows the students to take the help of scribes in the examination. The college follows strict rules issued by the university while granting permission to take scribe for the examinations. A physically disabled / blind / hearing impaired candidate and the scribes for such a candidate shall be allowed an extra time of 20 minutes per hour. As the hearing impaired students are having language problems, possibilities of grammar mistakes, mistakes in building the sentences may occur. The answer papers shall be identified separately and evaluated with additional care.

ORDER

Sanction has been accorded by the Joint Registrar (Exam II) to the following six mentally challenged candidates, appearing for the various University Examinations – 2018-2019, being granted grace mark of 25% of the total marks in theory Examinations provided the candidates secure a minimum of 10% in the theory Examination, as they are backward in language ability. Sanction has also been granted to an extra time of thirty minutes for answering each paper of three hours duration with proportionate reduction of time for papers of shorter duration and service of a scribe.

The Principal/Chief Superintendent is authorised to appoint a suitable scribe for the candidate who could neither be an employee of the college nor one who is interested in the candidate. The remuneration to the scribe may be paid by the Principal/Chief Superintendent at the rate of Rs 250 /- (Rupees two hundred and fifty only) per paper after claiming the amount in separate bills immediately after the examination as per UO read as paper (5) above.

The candidates will be eligible for the above mentioned benefits for all the examinations whether regular or supplementary, taken within the period of above course, provided they pursue the course without any break, and the disability is of a permanent nature. Separate orders are required to be obtained for each examination after the course period.
