2. Introduction

Njaruneelian important settlement of tribals in the Western Ghats, in Peringammala panchayath of Thiruvananthapuram, is the abode of 400 tribal families, with a total population of around 1650 people.Njaruneeli, though known for its scenic beauty and tribal medicine, experiences severe socio-economic and educational backwardness.
