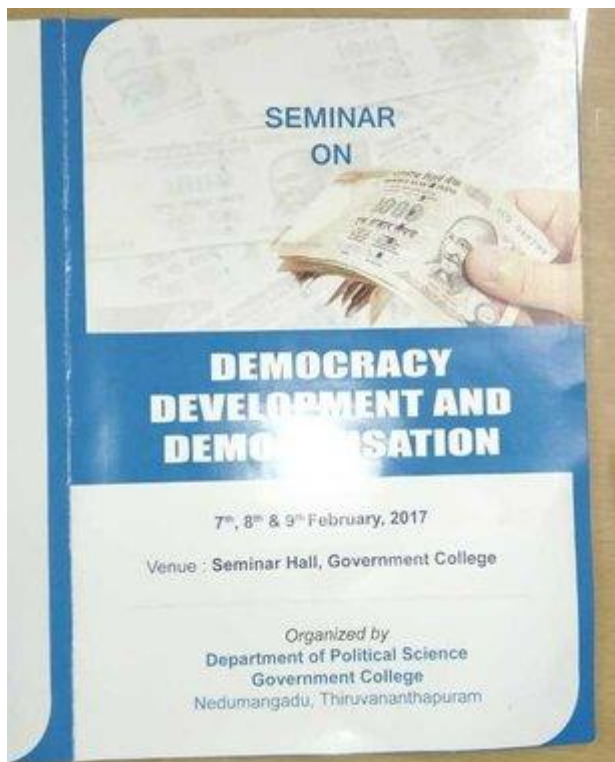
## **2. National Seminar on 'Changing Patterns of Political Culture in India: Challenges and Responses'**

Department of Political Science organised a three day national seminar on Changing Patterns of Political Culture in India on December 2015.

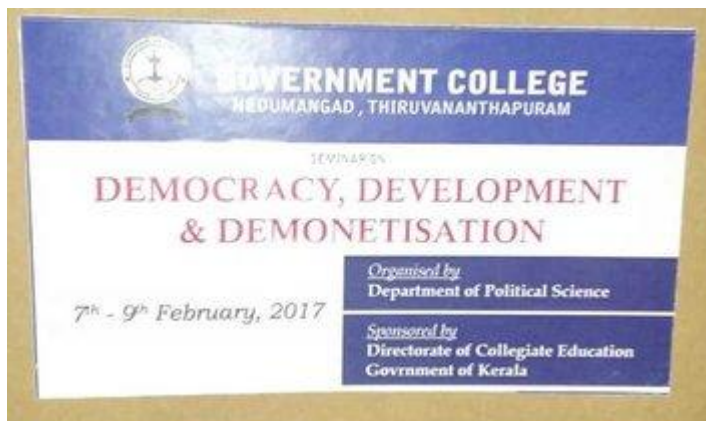


### **3. National Seminar on Democracy, Development, and Demonetisation**

Republic day is celebrated on 26<sup>th</sup> January every year organising various activities for the students.

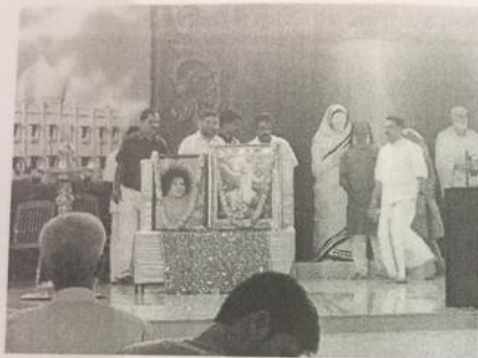
