THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter referred to as 'MoU') is executed this the 27th day of March 2019 at Thiruvananthapuram between the Principal, Government College, Nedumangad, Thiruvananthapuram- 695541 (hereinafter referred to as 'the College' which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns) of the FIRST PART and the Director, Centre for Development Studies (CDS), Prasanth Nagar, Ulloor, Thiruvananthapuram-695011 (hereinafter referred to as 'The Centre' which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include it's successors and assigns) of the SECOND PART

WHEREAS, the College is an arts and science college situated in a rural area of Nedumangad in Thiruvananthapuram district owned and established by the Government of Kerala. The Centre is a premier social science research and teaching institution in Applied Economics under the aegis of Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), New Delhi, and Government of Kerala.

AND WHEREAS, the KN Raj Teaching & Research Fellowship scheme at the Centre has introduced a new scheme called 'Mentoringa Government College' in which the Centre will adopt the Department of Economics of a Government College in Kerala for three years to enable the faculty and students of the department to further No. 10752 in prove their knowledge and understanding of economic theory and its application

AND WHEREAS, the parties after detailed discussion, have agreed for entering into this MoU.

NOW IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PREMISES, THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Objectives of the Scheme

The major objectives of the scheme include:

- a. The faculty of the Centre will help the College faculty in improving the teaching of micro and macroeconomics, econometrics, research methodology etc.
- b. Three faculty members of the Department will be given free membership in the KN Raj Library at the Centre for three years
- c. Both the faculty and students of the Department will be included in the CDS mailing list for informing all the academic events at the Centre.
- d. Faculty of the Centre will occasionally visit the College for delivering lectures/seminars.
- e. The Centre will help the Department to strengthen its library and computing

f. In return, the College faculty has to improve the teaching and research skills and to give high quality training and class room teaching to students.

- g. The College does not have any right to claim further benefits/advantages other than mentioned above as per this agreement from the Centre. The Centre's liability as per this agreement limits as above.
- h. The above benefits offered to the College are not a matter of right and the Centre has the right to deny the above benefits due to any unforeseen circumstances.

2. Administrative Arrangements

The College shall setup a programme management committee in consultation with the Centre for the smooth functioning of the scheme.

3. Programme Management

A programme management committee consisting of the following members shall guide the scheme.

- Director, Centre for Development Studies
- Coordinator of the Ph.D Programme
- 3. Coordinator of the M.Phil programme
- 4. Coordinator of the M A Programme
- A representative of the Screening Committee of the K N Raj Training and Fellowship Programme to be nominated by Director, CDS.
- 6. Principal, Government College, Nedumangad
- 7. Head, Department of Economics, Government College Nedumangad

4. Disposal of Assets

The ownership of any asset supplied to the College by the Centre for strengthening the library and computing facilities will belongs to the Centre and the College has to take prior approval of the Centre to dispose the same.

5. Arbitration

In the event of any difference or dispute arising out of the interpretation in connection with this MoU, the parties shall consult each other and decide the matter amicably. If amicable settlement is not possible, the decision of the Centre will prevail.

This MoU shall be governed by the Laws of India and in the event of dispute and/or differences arising out of or in connection with the terms of this MoU, the Court of Thiruvananthapuram shall have the exclusive jurisdiction in respect thereof.

All notices and correspondences shall be in writing and may be sent by registered post or by e-mail to the other side at its address set forth herein above or at such other address as such party may subsequently notify. All such notices shall be deemed to have been given or served when delivered.
