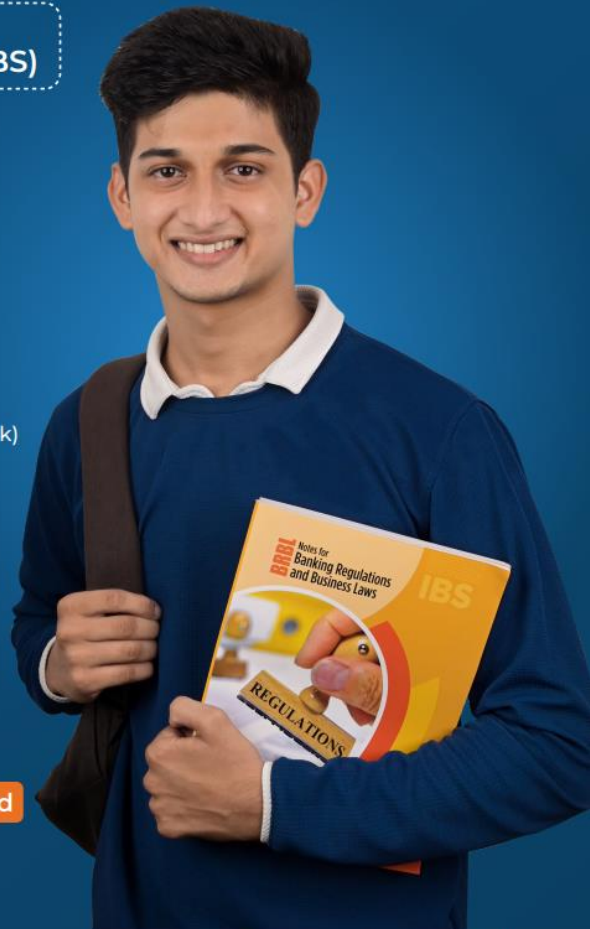

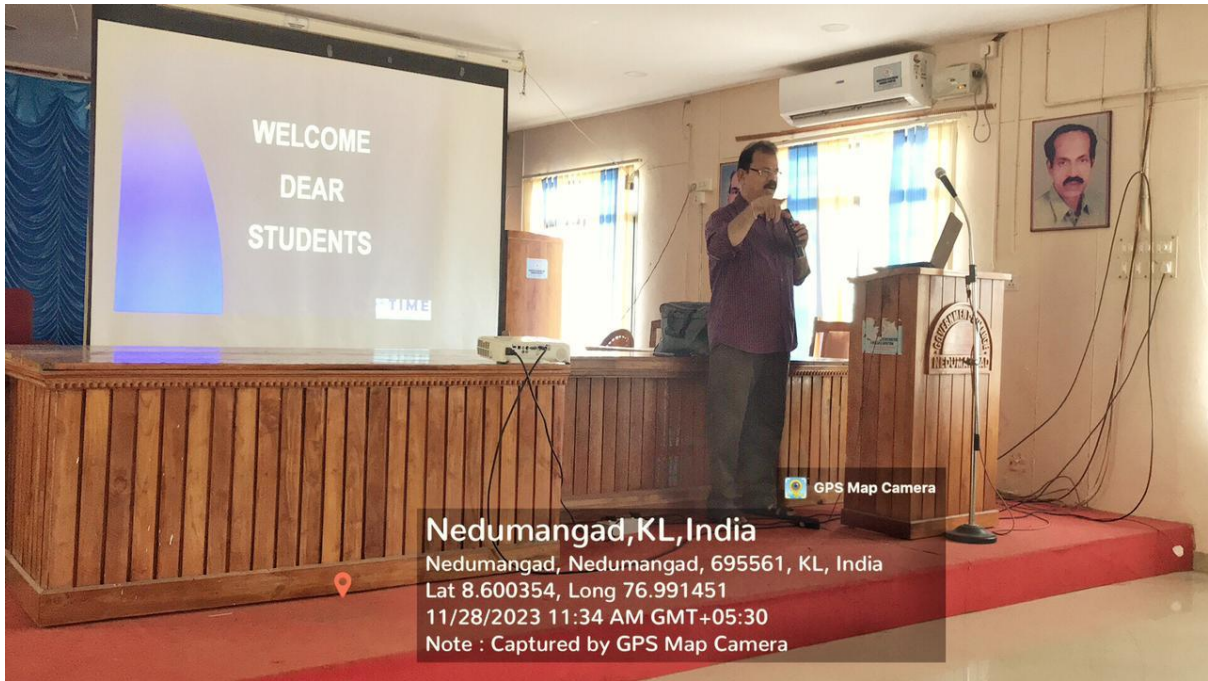

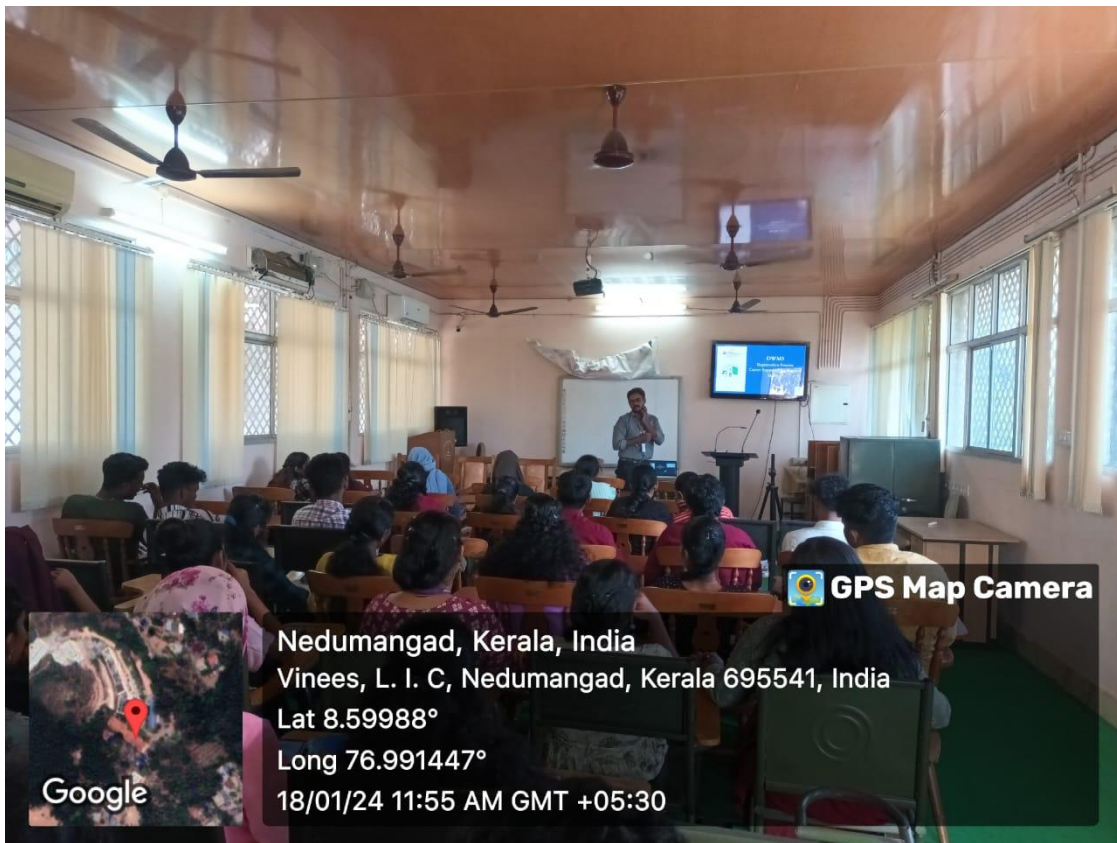


UGC NET Orientation programme


