Summary Report of the Programmes

Government College Nedumangad is at the forefront of carrying out a variety of activities for addressing the local disadvantages especially the issues related to employment, health, literacy, education, housing and environment. Our college has a Social Service and Extension Activities Cell (SEAC) and a number of clubs are functioning under SEAC.

Summary of the Activities 2018-19

1. Lunch for Destitute

Our college provides food for destitute and patients of the district hospital on special occasions like Onam, Xmas, and Ramsan. The programme is conducted on 05/06/2018, 09/10/2018, 10/10/2018, 23/12/2018, and 24/12/2018.

2. Cleaning Public Places

The college community is very much aware of the necessity to protect and maintain public places and under took various initiatives in this regard. This includes Protection of Govt. Schools, Protection of "Ponnara Sreedhar Park, KSRTC Bus Station cleaning, cleaning of Nedumangad Market,, cleaning of Public well and Pond in Nedumangad Municipality. These programmes were carried out on, 04/06/2018, 15/08/2018, and 31/10/2018, and 26/01/2018.

2. Helping hand

People with serious ailments often visit our college and seeks financial help. College always respond positively to such requests and provide maximum help for such credible requests. Donations were given to Cancer patients to meet their medical expenses. Dr. Anzer R. N, Assistant professor of Commerce is one of the executive members of palliative care club in the Nedumangadu Municipality.

4.Awareness Programmes

Various clubs in the college organise number of awareness programmes every year to give awareness to local people, parents and students. These include health awareness programme, Road safety, Anti Ragging, Anti-drug Campaign and Digital literacy. Exhibitions, awareness class, surveys, and flash mobs are organised by the students of the college with the help of Hospitals, Excise Department and Police Department. Various awareness programmes were undertaken on 18/06/2018, 30/07/2018,14/08/2018, 06/09/2018 and 30/01/2019.

5.PSC Coaching.

PSC coaching classes were also provided to college students as well as people from outside the college. This programme was organized in the months of February and March 2017.

6. Food for Labourers

A number of workers are engaged in various construction projects in the campus. We implemented a provision to provide them with food at subsidised rate from the college canteen. This proved great help for the labourers and their families.

7. Training for Ayalkuttam (cluster of families)

Training classes were provided to Ayalkuttam units in paper bag, cloth bag, soap and candle making under the ED club of the college on 13/02/2019.

Summary of the Activity 2017-18

1. Lunch for the Destitute

Every year our college arranges food for the poor and destitute around Nedumangad town on Onam, Xmas and Ramsan festivals.

2. Open Day

As part of the Open Day, exhibitions are organized by various departments, clubs and NSS unit of the College, as well as other governmental and non governmental agencies like ISRO, Keltron, BSNL, ANERT, ASAP, Fire Force, Kudumbasree, Anti Narcotic Cell, Archives, Vanashree etc. Seminars, Art Eve, Fun Corner, Tek Talks, Career Manthra, Medical Camp,

SWAP Shop, Book Fest, Dental Camp, GST Awareness, Kaviyarang, Quiz Programmes, Cancer Awareness Programme, were also conducted on the occasion. About 800 students from various schools, Colleges and other institutions and 250 people from various walks of life attended the programme. The concept of Open Day demanded the participation of various stake holders, sharing of academic achievements, research output and resources of the college.

3. Coaching for PSC examinations

Public Service Commission is the major recruiting agency functioning in the state to recruit young aspirants to government service. Competition for these examinations is huge and the institution wants to help the students and the local people by arranging coaching for PSC examinations ensuring employment and social mobility. Our college organised coaching for PSC Examinations in the month of February and March 2018.

4. Awareness Programmes

In the academic year 2017-18 college organised awareness programmes on Road safety (11/07/2017), Drug abuse(20/09/2017), cyber crimes(25/10/2017), digital literacy(8/11/2017), alcohol abuse(16/01/2018), aids awareness (23/01/2018) and cancer awareness (14/03/2018).
