Under the title socio economic empowerment of Njaraneeli tribal village, we adopted the village and implemented a number of promotion programmes for the native tribes. Major activities include socio economic survey of the region, anti drug, anti alcohol awareness campaign, Literacy and e literacy awareness campaigns, health awareness programmes and medical camps, PSC coaching classes, Library, self employment training, road construction, SWAP shops and entrepreneurships training.

Award Winning NSS


