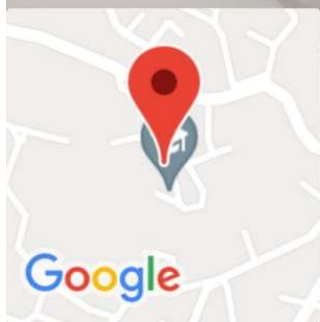
Measures initiated by the Institution for the Promotion of Gender Equity – 2020-21

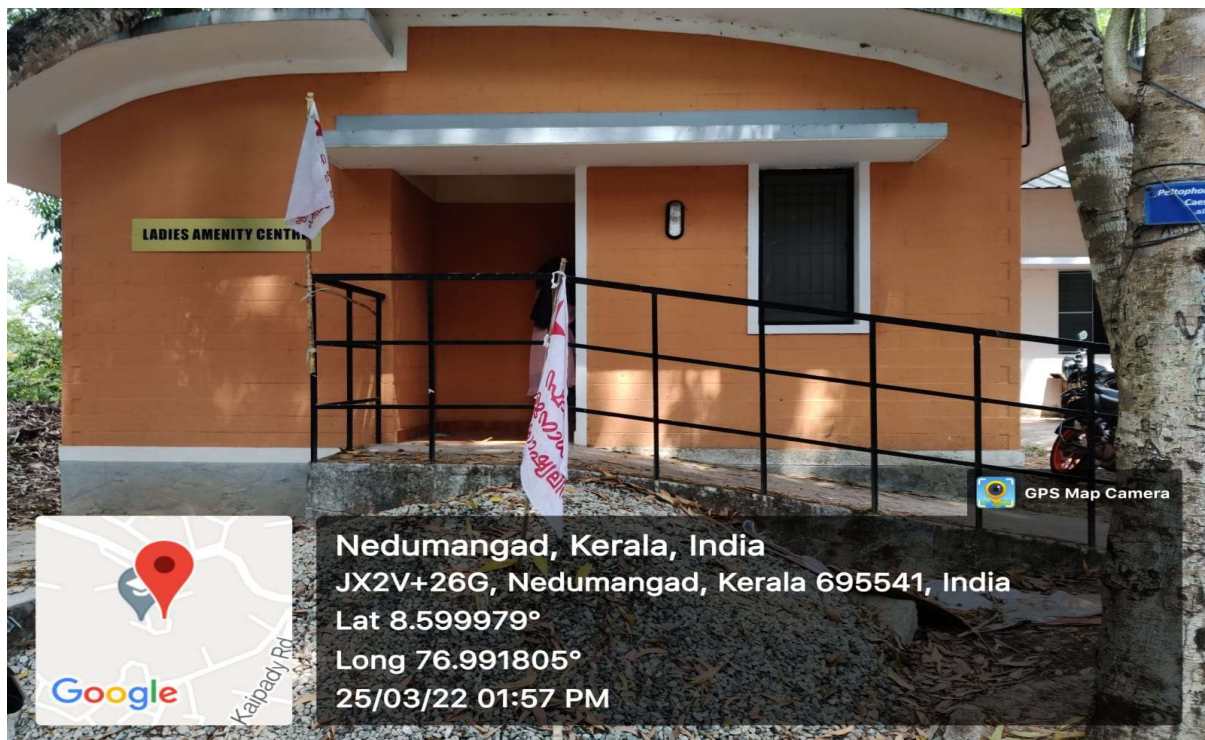


(c) Common Rooms:
