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1. INTRODUCTION

Govt College, Nedumangad was established in 1981 at Akkottupara, one kilometre away from the Nedumangad Town. It has 11 Departments and offers 6 undergraduate courses viz. BA Malayalam, BA History, BA Economics, BSc Mathematics, BSc Physics with Computer Application (PCA), BCom and two post graduate courses; MA History and M Com. The college has been recognized by UGC and eligible for UGC funding under section 2-(f) and 12 B. of UGC Act.

Now the college is about to enter a significant phase of expansion and up gradation as it has been selected for the funding under 'centre of excellence' among govt colleges with a financial assistance of 300 Lakh by the Government and an additional Basic Infrastructure development assistance from RUSA for an amount of Rs 200 Lakh. In order to utilize the amounts judiciously and economically, we would like to prepare a master plan for the college infrastructure development in the available 9 acres land, with an appropriate architecture design for creating an academic ambience.

3. FORTHCOMING DEVELOPMENTS

1. RUSA Fund allotment

RUSA has allotted an amount of Rupees **Two crore** for the development and maintenance of infra structural facilities in the college. The planning Board of the college has decided for the construction of a PG block with 4 rooms, Maintenance of Malayalam and Mathematics Departments (Roofing, Tiling etc), Renovation of Seminar Hall.

2. Centre of Excellence Fund

The Govt. of Kerala has identified ten colleges for funding under 'centre of excellence' and identified two colleges, including our college, for funding in the current financial year. An amount of Rupees **Three crore** was allotted. The planning board of the college has decided to construct a Central Library and Online Resource Centre Block, Faculty Development and Training Centre; Students' Support Centre, Language Lab Facility and ICT & Website Development.

4. PROPOSAL ALREADY SUBMITTED

1. SPECIAL INVESTMENT PACKAGE (SIP)

During the revised Budget speech (2016-17), a 'special Investment Package' was announced by Hon'ble Finance Minister for various Govt departments. As part of it, it was decided to create Premium basic facilities in 48 Government Arts and Science colleges within next two years. Govt. College Nedumangad has got an amount of Rupees 885 Lakh for the basic infrastructure development.

A project concept note was sent to the college by the department of Higher Education in which the SIP comprises the following **mandatory components** for the utilization of the SIP fund:

- 1. High Tech Smart class rooms
- 2. Computer Lab with net working facility
- 3. Modern laboratory
- 4. State of the Art Library

The rest of the fund can be utilized for other infra structure developments such as developing academic space, construction of common amenity centre for girls, toilet facility for the boys, drinking water facility, establishing alternative energy sources and waste disposal mechanisms etc. As per the note given by the Higher Education department, we prepare and submitted a proposal for the preparation of DPR as follows:
